Exam paper sections	Supporting information
Section One: Multiple choice <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 20% • 20 Questions • 40 minutes 	Questions will enable candidates to demonstrate knowledge and understanding from all course content without having to formulate a written answer. Stimulus materials in the form of diagrams, graphs could be used.
Section Two: Short response <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 35% • 6 questions • 60 minutes 	From any of the content sub-headings providing even coverage of content. Questions will be well scaffolded.
Section Three: Production Practices Response <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10% • 1 question • 20 minutes 	A compulsory question to focus on the practical application of knowledge and skills directly related to a production enterprise studied by the student.
Section Four: Extended response <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 35% • 4 questions where students choose 3 • 60 minutes 	Students are required to answer three questions from a choice of four. Two questions selected from each content organiser i.e. Knowledge foundations, and Management of selected enterprise for sustainability. Questions will be well scaffolded and worded to assist students to accurately interpret the intent of the question.
