Advice for candidates

- Provide additional information in your answers to fully explain or describe concepts as required.
- Structure your responses to clearly indicate the parts of questions.

Advice for teachers

- Advise candidates whose writing is illegible that this makes marking very difficult.
- Use the course terminology at all times.

Comments on specific sections and questions

Section One: Multiple-choice (15 Marks)

All candidates attempted all questions. Candidates found Questions 5 and 6 were the easiest and Questions 11 and 12 the most challenging.

Section Two: Short answer (74 Marks)

There were eight compulsory questions in this section. Candidates needed to include additional information to fully explain the statements they made and demonstrate their application of knowledge in order to achieve full marks.

Section Three: Extended answer

Candidates were required to respond to two questions from a choice of three. Question 26 was the most popular choice, selected by 96 candidates.
