<p>Adolescence</p>	<p>Motor development, Cephalocaudal pattern.</p>
<p>This is development outwards: motor development away from the trunk. Example: Arm, then hands, then fingers</p>	<p>Motor development. Gross-to-specific pattern.</p>
<p>Ductus venosus</p>	<p>Ductus arteriosus</p>
<p>After giving birth the mother undergoes changes. The reproductive organs return to normal size. This period last about eight weeks.</p>	<p>The initiation and maintenance of milk.</p>
<p>Colostrum</p>	<p>The time in a person's life when they become sexually mature.</p>
<p>Foramen ovale</p>	<p>This is a protective layer of waxy material covering the baby during labour.</p>
