Adolescence	Motor development, Cephalocaudal pattern.
This is development outwards: motor development away from the trunk. Example: Arm, then hands, then fingers	Motor development. Gross-to-specific pattern.
Ductus venosus	Ductus arteriosus
After giving birth the mother undergoes changes. The reproductive organs return to normal size. This period last about eight weeks.	The initiation and maintenance of milk.
Colostrum	The time in a person's life when they become sexually mature.
Foramen ovale	This is a protective layer of waxy material covering the baby during labour.
