- I. Read the previous Pen Pal recruitments and answer, **IN ENGLISH**, the questions below.
(11 marks in total)
- (i) What type of person does Akemi want to become friends with? (1 mark)
Somebody who likes music and movies
- (ii) Describe the difference between Peter and Mike in terms of hobbies and interests. (1 mark)
Peter has an interest in Japanese and Japanese culture
Mike's hobby is computers
- (iii) Explain the difference(s) between Mike and Angela in terms of cooking. (2 marks)
Mike likes cooking (Japanese cooking) and his speciality is seafood spaghetti
Angela is bad at cooking
- (iv) How do the future aspirations of Akemi and Angela differ? (2 marks)
Akemi wants to become an actress or a singer
Angela wants to be a famous photographer
- (v) If you had an interest in playing sports, who would make the best pen friend? Why? (2 marks)
Angela. She recently started aerobics and she also likes to play racket ball
- (vi) If you were fascinated with things Japanese, who would make the most suitable pen friend? Explain. (3 marks)
Peter. He loves to study Japanese, especially kanji
He's interested in Japanese culture
He loves Japanese sports, animation and comic books

II. Read the previous Letter and answer, **IN ENGLISH**, the questions below. **(12 marks)**

- (i) Give as much detail as possible as to where Katy lives. (2 marks)
She lives in a town called Cairns in Australia

- (ii) Why is Katy writing to Haruna? (2 marks)
She wants to become friends/pen friends with Haruna

- (iii) Explain Katy's hobby. (3 marks)

- (iv) What is Katy so looking forward to? (1 mark)

III. Read the previous diary entry and answer, **IN ENGLISH**, the questions below. **(11 marks)**

- (i) Why did Trent decide to have rice? (1 mark)

- (ii) Why did Trent's host mother drive him to school? (1 mark)
Because he went to school for the first time (today)
- (iii) Why was Trent so nervous? (1 mark)
Because he gave a self-introduction in Japanese in front of his classmates
- (iv) What did Trent do during the maths and science lessons? Why? (2 marks)
He wrote an e-mail to his family because he couldn't understand the lessons and the Japanese was too fast for him
- (v) Why was Trent so happy at school? (2 marks)
